Sports Day – Friday, June 7

Our school Sports Day is coming up on <u>Friday, June 7</u>. Please join us to watch the kids participate in a range of fun events. If your child is NOT going to be attending, please let us know at the office ASAP so that even teams can be created. It is a hot lunch day and our PAC will be having a concession stand as well. Please order your lunches using our PAC hot lunch program and only send money with your child to be used at the PW concession – <u>no "Skip The</u> <u>Dishes" or pizza deliveries, please!</u>

The theme for this year's sports day is "A Day At The Beach". The day will start with a 'Wheels Parade' for all students to join in with decorated <u>non-motorized wheels</u> if they like. All participating students MUST wear a helmet. Please note the Visitor parking in the turnaround and street parking in front of the school will be blocked off to ensure a safe route for the parade. Those students participating may drop their wheels off in the Gym before school and all students will start the day as normal in their classrooms for attendance. Parents may watch the parade from the centre of the traffic circle at the front of the school. <u>After the parade, wheels can be taken home or to your vehicle immediately OR can be taken to the Gym where they will be locked up for the rest of the day. The Gym will not be opened again until 2:00 - no exceptions!</u> Students will return to classes to get information about their mixed-grade colour teams to participate in a series of stations on the field that will be run by our Grade 7 students. Lunch will follow (students may eat with parents and other family members or friends as long as there is adult supervision), and when it is over students return to their classes for afternoon attendance. They will then go with their classes to the field for a pre-school race, tug-of-war, and water-balloon toss events. There will be an early dismissal at approximately 2:00.



Any bus students or students not picked up at 2:00 will remain at the school for their regular pick up time.

We hope to see lots of spectators out to help us celebrate this special event!

Music Performances – Tuesday, June 18

Our music teacher, Mrs. Kato, has been working hard with all our classes to develop their understanding and skill with music. To demonstrate what students have learned this year, we will be inviting parents a concert featuring our primary and intermediate students and choir. Pinewood Sports Day - "A Day At The Beach" - Friday, June 7, 2019 -

Welcome to the Pinewood Sports Day! The following is a list of APPROXIMATE times the events will be happening.

We hope for good weather ... even if it is raining, Sports Day will still go ahead with a 2:00 dismissal. If it is pouring, the day will be altered with events taking place inside the school. Please have kids dressed for any weather!

For the safety and comfort of all students we ask that **NO PETS come to Sports Day** with families.

Please note changes in parking for that day. To accommodate the Wheels Parade safely, <u>there will be no parking from</u> 8:00-10:00 am in the guest parking spaces and on the street in front of the school between the driveway entrance and <u>exit</u>. Because it is a day of physical activity, we encourage everyone to walk that day where possible.

Lost and Found items will be put on display and unclaimed items will be donated to charity at the end of the month.

8:40 - 9:00	Students bring decorated wheels and helmets to the Gym. Please enter from the <u>playground</u> side doors.
9:00 - 9:10	Attendance in classrooms
9:10 - 9:45	 Decorated Wheels Parade Please remember it's a parade, not a race! Bikes, wagons, skateboards, etc. – all students may participate but "wheels" or "riders" must be decorated. ALL students <u>MUST</u> wear helmets, <u>no exceptions</u>. NO WEAPONS, WATER GUNS, CANDY, or MOTORIZED VEHICLES. Parents can watch from the inner traffic circle and sidewalk areas. Please let your child know if you are taking their bike immediately after the parade. All remaining wheels will be locked in the Gym <u>until the day is over</u> and can only be retrieved at 2:00 – no exceptions.
9:45 - 10:00	 <u>INDOOR RECESS</u> <u>all students go to classrooms, use bathrooms, get drinks of water</u>
10:00 - 10:20	 Teachers prepare students Pin on coloured name tags & deliver to starting station.
10:20 - 11:50	 <u>10 Stations</u> 9 minutes each (includes moving and explaining) - wait for signal to start Students are in <u>family groupings</u>. Please check with your child for their first station.
11:50 - 12:00	<u>Clean-up</u>
12:00 - 12:55	 LUNCH Students return to classrooms for lunch (PAC-ordered or packed), teachers will dismiss. Students may eat outside with their family. <u>NO outside delivery services allowed</u> (i.e. Skip the Dishes, pizza delivery etc support our PAC instead at their Concession!) Parents of primary children: please pick up your child in their classroom if they are joining you outside for lunch. Lunch ends at 12:55 and kids return to classrooms.
12:55 - 2:00	 Afternoon Attendance, then Teachers take classes out to field for afternoon races Pre-School Race Grade Tug-of-Wars Parent Balloon Toss Grade 7 Water Balloon Toss Clean-up ALL students MUST return to class for dismissal at approximately 2:00. Any students requiring bus or day care service, or those not picked up by parents at 2:00, will remain at the school until 3:00 dismissal.
