To all of our Pinewood families for supporting our students as they start a new school year! your support as well. Transitions can sometimes be difficult for students, and we have learned that positive encouragement goes a long way. It's going to be a great year and each of the students were very thoughtfully placed in their new class for the year – it will be fun for them to grow and learn with a new group of classmates. It often takes time for students to adapt to a new learning environment. We appreciate your support during this time of transition and encourage you to reach out to your child's classroom teacher if they need some extra support.

Some background: The number of staff members assigned to Pinewood Elementary is decided by the Delta School District and is based on projected student enrolment. Enrolment numbers and class size guidelines affect the configuration of classes. Combined classes are an organizational necessity based on student numbers. Research also indicates that multi-age groupings (combined classes) provide very positive learning environments for children. Studies show that children in multi-age classes learn to become more independent, responsible learners and develop a greater degree of social responsibility. Achievement levels of these students are as good as, or better than, the achievement levels of students placed in single grade classrooms.

Assigning students to classes is a very complex task that takes into consideration a variety of factors including learning styles and strengths, what a student can achieve in relation to the goals of the curriculum, degree of independence in work habits, social and personal needs, age and physical maturity, previous placements, diverse learning needs of the students, as well as parental insight. Our objective is to create balanced classes, taking all the above into consideration.

Partners in Health and Safety

We would like to ask families to review the following health and safety routines:

- •Wash and sanitize hands often
- •Practice good respiratory etiquette by sneezing and coughing into your elbow
- •Respect the personal space of others
- •Stay home when sick

Be Prepared

Please ensure students come fully prepared for the day:

Clothing & Sunscreen - Please send your child with proper clothing for the weather, as we will spend time outdoors. Sunscreen should be applied at home. Parents are also encouraged to send an extra set of clothes, in a sealed plastic bag in your child's backpack, labelled with your child's name.

Food & Water - Please ensure your child brings snacks, a refillable water bottle and a lunch to school each day. As we will be continuing to limit access to the building, lunches may only be dropped off in urgent situations. Should a student forget his/her lunch, they will not go hungry. We will have some food supplies on hand for emergencies, or families will be contacted by Mrs. Verma.

Please make every effort to have students at school on time so they can enter directly through their classroom doors. If students arrive late to school, they may wait outside the front door to be let into the building and sign in at the office.

Student Planners

This year, some teachers have opted to use student planners. Individual classes will be notified if planners will be required and a notice will be sent home outlining how to cover the cost of the planner.

Parking and Drop Offs

Traffic can be very busy at the front of our school. The traffic circle can be used as a drop off and pick up lane – it is only for a quick exit of the vehicle and pick up if the student is there and ready to enter the car. We have 4 visitor parking spots at the end of the traffic circle and three accessible spots as well for those with a permit. You can also leave your car on neighbouring streets and walk onto the school grounds. Please be mindful of our neighbours' driveways and follow all signage. The parking lot is for staff only between 8:00am and 4:00pm and is not to be used for pick up and drop off. More detailed information is available in the attached Parking and Driveway letter.
