### Kindergarten Registration - 2024-2025

Kindergarten registration for September takes place mid-February each year. A child may be registered to attend Kindergarten in September if their fifth birthday occurs on or before December 31st of the current year.

Kindergarten registration for the 2024/2025 school year will be held from February 12-23, 2024. Please register ONLINE for your <u>catchment</u> area school during this period of time. In-person registration at Pinewood will be available on Wednesday, February 14. For verification of your catchment area school, please check the School Locator. Instructions on how to register will be posted on the district website in early February.

Please have the following documents ready to upload with your child's registration (all documents must be received for registration to be accepted):

- 1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport) (registration will not be accepted until proof of birth date is received).
- 2. Proof of citizenship for both the parent and the student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card).
- 3. BC Services Card (please include both sides of card)
- 4. Proof of Residency (Property Taxes current receipt, purchase/rental agreement or rental receipt).
