Lockdown Drill

Today, we conducted a Lockdown Drill. Just as we prepare our students to properly respond to a fire drill, they also need to be aware of the proper response during a "lockdown" and "hold and secure". We encourage you to discuss this at home with your child.

All schools in the District are required to hold Lockdown and Hold & Secure drills. The purpose of the drills is to provide training for students and staff, so everyone knows

what to do in the event of a safety threat.

Parents and members in our community may have noticed a police presence today. We partner with the Delta Police in drills like this as they will be taking over and coordinating the response in such a situation. Their practice in navigating our halls and communicating with our staff is vital in their response preparedness as well.

Student Illness/Reporting Absences

Just a reminder to check student wellness before coming to school. If symptoms of illness are present, please assess whether students are better off staying home. Also, please be sure to call or email our office to notify the school if your child will be absent for any reason.
